## **Brain Gain: Fundamental Research in India**

Subir Sarkar will review the evolving research landscape in India over the past 40 years. Globalisation - spearheaded by international scientific collaboration - has provided an effective framework for self-assessment and exploring new directions. India is well-placed to recoup the far-sighted investments made in its research infrastructure, in particular by attracting researchers from abroad..

Subir Sarkar is Head of the Particle Theory Group at the Rudolf Peierls Centre for Theoretical Physics, University of Oxford, where he has been on the academic staff since 1990 and was made Professor in 2006. He joined TIFR as a graduate student in 1974 obtaining his PhD in the Cosmic Rays Group. He was a staff member during 1979-84 and Adjunct Professor during 2006-09
