Selections (rephrased)

Regulations of the Unified Labor Law No. 12 of 2003

Chapter two, Employing Women

- **All provisions regulating the employment of workers shall apply to working women, without discrimination between them**

Egyptian CHILD LAW

(70)

- **The right to maternity leave for a period of three months after childbirth, with full pay** (Three times throughout her service period)

(72)

- **Unpaid leave for a period of two years to care for her child.** (Three times throughout her service period)





Fig (1):gender distribution of bachelor degree students in various majors in Ain Shams university (2022-2023) .




Fig (2): Number of female and male staff members in physics and biophysics specializations at Mansoura university
